



33 BIBLICAL "ONE ANOTHERS"

The Greek word *allelon* means "one another, each other; mutually, reciprocally," and it occurs 100 times in the New Testament. As "members of one another" (Romans 12:5, Ephesians 4:25), we were created for relationship – first with God then with each other. Community is foundational to who we are. As the Body of Christ, we are called to love and serve one another, to sacrificially put each other's needs ahead of our own.

We invite you to pray through these 33 *One Another* verses, meditating on what it means to "love one another deeply from the heart" as we learn to selflessly walk each other home.

2. Wash one another's feet (1 John 13:14)
3. Love one another (John 13:34, 35; John 15:12, 17; Romans 13:8, 1 John 3:11, 23; 1 John 4:7, 11, 12; 2 John 5; 1 Peter 3:8, 4:8)
4. Be devoted to one another (Romans 12:10)
5. Honor one another (Romans 12:10)
6. Live in harmony with one another (Romans 12:16, 1 Peter 3:8)
7. Stop passing judgment on one another (Romans 14:13)
8. Accept one another (Romans 15:7)
9. Instruct one another (Romans 15:14)
10. Greet one another (Romans 16:16, 1 Corinthians 16:20, 2 Corinthians 13:12; 1 Peter 5:14)

30. Confess your sins to each other (James 5:16)
31. Pray for each other (James 5:16)
32. Offer hospitality to one another (1 Peter 4:9)
33. Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another (1 Peter 5:5)
