Yarn Suggestions: Any Worsted weight or Fingering. Worsted weight bookmarks are thicker.

Crochet Hook: "G"

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = chain
Sc = single
Dc = double
Hdc – Half double
Ss = slip stitch
St = stitch
Sk = skip
Rep = repeat
F/O = fasten off

HEARTFELT WINDOWS

Begin. Ch 34

Round 1 Ch 34. Sc in 2nd Ch from hook and in the next 32. (33 St) TURN

Round 2 Ch1, Hdc in same St. *Ch2, Sk2, Hdc in next* Rep from * to * 9 times. Ch2, Sk2 (Hdc2, Ch2, Hdc2 in end St). Continuing around *Ch2, Sk2, Hdc in next* Rep from * to * 10 times. Ch2, Ss in same St. F/O and Weave in ends.

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FLOWERS ABLOOM

Begin. Ch 34

Round 1 Sc in 2nd Ch from hook and in the next 31. Sc2 in the next Ch. Continuing around, Sc in the next 31. Sc2 in the last Ch. Join to 1st Sc with a Ss.

Round 2 Ch1, Sc in same St. Sk2, *Dc5 in next St. Sk2, Sc in next St.* Rep between * 4 times. Sk1, Dc3 in next 3 Sts. Sk1, Sc in next St. Sk1. * Dc5 in next, Sk2, Sc in next St.* Rep between * 4 times. Sk1, Ss in next St and F/O and weave in ends.
