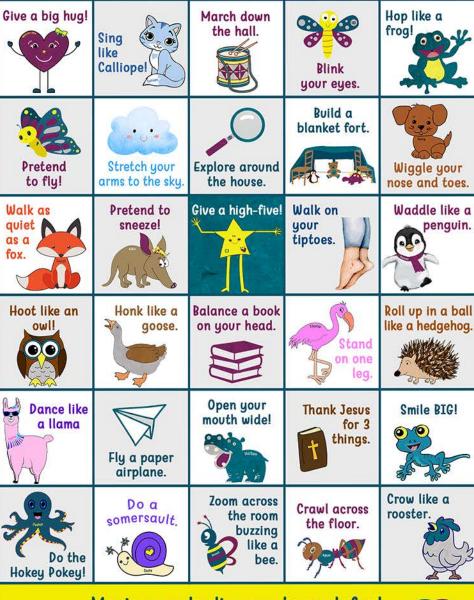

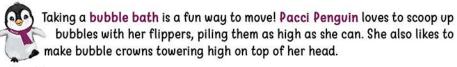


MORE FUN WAYS TO MOVE!
