INTERCESSORY PRAYERS TO GET YOU STARTED

FOR HEALING

Open our eyes to see beyond the pain, the illness, and these circumstances to Your calling on [name's] life. Fill [him/her] with hope as [he/she] waits patiently and expectantly on You! FOR STRENGTH

Jesus, You walked this earth. You understand our brokenness. You know our pain. I pray for those I know who are anxious, lonely, hurting, desperate, or living in fear. Soothe their pain, calm their fears, and fill them with Your undeniable peace. In Your mercy, Lord, hold them close, strengthening and encouraging them for this day. Amen.

Chronic Joy

FOR COMFORT

Lord, it's so hard to watch [name] endure so much pain. There is so little I can do—but You, O Lord, You stilled the wind and the waves with a single word. You stilled the wind and the waves.
