- lowers high cortisol levels
- relieves tension and stress
- decreases anxiety
- reduces depression
- lessens loneliness
- increases emotion-focused coping
- distracts us from pain and other symptoms
- improves breathing and increases lung capacity
- strengthens the immune system
- stimulates the parasympathetic nervous system
- enhances memory and increases neuroplasticity
