THE GREEK & HEBREW NAMES OF GOD

The Greek and Hebrew names for God are wonderful ways to learn more about Him. We are familiar with a few, like Abba or El Shaddai, though others may be new to us (such as Elohenu Olam or Peleh Yo'etz). Read through these 81 names. When one catches your attention, read its translation, then turn to the Scripture verse and read it in context. Ask God what He wants to show you about Himself through that name, then journal the your thoughts.
